Felstead's research focuses on art and computing through the relationship of digital environments to lived experience. She attended the Royal College of Art, London from 2017–18, undertaking Associate Research after being awarded the coveted Anne and Gordon Samstag International Visual Arts Scholarship (\$100K AUD). Felstead previously completed a Masters of Fine Arts (Research) at Monash University in 2014.

Felstead was an artist in residence at Banff Centre for Art, Canada in the program Digital Promises with funding from the Mary E Hofstetter Legacy Fund for Excellence in the Visual Arts and an Asialink artist in residence at Objectifs Centre for Photography and Filmmaking, Singapore, funded by Australia Council amongst others. Felstead has had solo representations of her work at the Margaret Lawrence Gallery, VCA; St Heliers, Abbotsford Convent; Bendigo Visual Art Gallery; Objectifs Centre for Photography and Filmmaking, Singapore and West Space.
